



Glencoe's Academic Planning Night

This year's Planning Night will be held on **Thursday, February 16** and will begin at **7:00pm in Glencoe's Auditorium**. Glencoe Forecasting

Glencoe's AVID program

Glencoe will be taking applications for their AVID program. AVID stands for *Advancement Via Individual Determination* and is an elective class for "B-/C+ average" students who are interested in attending college and need academic support. This international program has been in place at Glencoe for three years and will provide students with organization and study skills needed for college-bound students. AVID students are generally first-generation college-bound students or underrepresented in higher education. The application process takes place at the end of February when the high school counselors come to forecast students.
